Dare to Dream Youth Empowerment Program

The Dare to Dream Youth Empowerment Program provides youth in grades 9–12 with hands-on experiences designed to build confidence, leadership, and career readiness.

Program participants engage in:

- Leadership development
- Career exploration and workforce readiness
- Entrepreneurship and financial literacy
- Personal development and goal setting
- Communication and teamwork skills

Youth also participate in:

- Job fairs
- Mock interviews
- Career exposure field trips
- Mentorship opportunities
